Dear Parents and Carers,

In last Sundays Gospel Jesus told another parable called the 'two sons'.

It describes how one son refuses to do what he has been asked but later repents and does it. The other son promises to do what he has been told but then changes his mind.

We learnt that, at the time of Jesus, many 'religious' people such as the the Pharisees knew lots about the religious laws and were able to teach others but didn't act in a way that pleased God. The parable teaches us that it's our actions that are important and speak far louder than our words.

We learnt about St Vincent de Paul who saw suffering around him, thought about what to do about it and then **acted**.

The children were told that we will be establishing a Mini Vinnies group in school to carry on the work of St Vincent de Paul.



Their job will be to **see** those in need, **think** about how to help them and **do** something about it.

Your child has completed an application form this week and I will be selecting the Mini Vinnies from these. I will let you know who has been successful in next weeks newsletter.

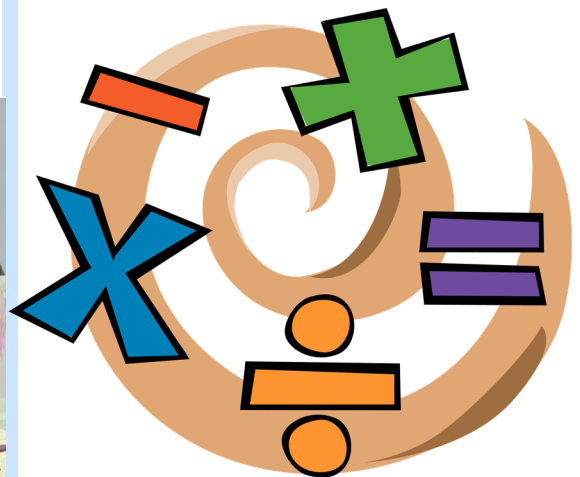


### Maths workshops for parents
