

In last Sundays Gospel Jesus told another parable called the 'tenant farmers'. In it he describes how the landowners servants are repeatedly killed when they attempt to collect the fruit from the tenants for the landowner. The story reaches its climax with the landowners son being sent and killed. This was a prophecy of Jesus' death and described how the many prophets sent before him had been rejected. The parable was also a warning.



Jesus describes himself as the 'cornerstone'. The first stone placed down and the one that the builder uses as his guide.

The children learnt that (just as in the parable) God gives us many chances but that if we truly wish to live life in all its fullness we must be guided by him and his son, just as the builder is guided by the cornerstone.

## Reading Workshop for Reception class






#### **Maths workshops for parents**

#### Year 2 Great Fire of London Workshop


