The Church choir have invited the children to join them this Sunday (17th **December)** at the 11am Mass for the third Sunday of Advent. It would be great to see as many children as possible.




#### This weeks attendance

Can I please remind you all that the children should only be consuming fruit and/or vegetables at breaktimes.











Your contributions give all the children of the school extra fabulous experiences.




Merry Christmas
