Last Sunday we celebrated the Epiphany. In whole school assembly on Tuesday we heard the story of the 4th wise man (Artaban).

Artaban has 3 gifts for the baby (a ruby, a sapphire and a pearl). As he travels to meet up with is 3 friends he is delayed after helping an injured man. He nurses him back to health and gives his sapphire in payment to the innkeeper. When he finally arrives in Bethlehem he finds out that he has missed the baby's birth and that the family have fled to Egypt because King Herod had ordered the killing of all babies. to a group of soldiers to stop them taking a baby from its mother. Left with 1 pearl Artaban searches for 33 years for the baby who is now a man. He finally arrives in Jerusalem on the day that Jesus is to be crucified. As he walks through the city he sees a slave girl being sold and she begs Artaban to free her. He uses the final pearl to obtain her freedom.

Disconsolate, he makes his way to the cross to see Jesus and inform him that he has no gift. I hope the children will be able to tell you what Jesus says next.

This week I have asked the children to think carefully about what they will gift to Jesus this year. It may be that they will try extra hard in school or remember to say thank you and please. It may be that they will give more to charity or pray for those in need. Talk with your children about what they will give to Jesus.



Valentine's disco coming up soon, dates to be confirmed.


