Dear Parents and Carers,

In last Sundays Gospel we heard the story of Jesus meeting Andrew, another disciple and Peter. He says to the Disciples 'What do you want?' In assembly we spoke about what we all *really* want and most people would agree that this is to live in happiness.

I showed the children the painting below by Jinho Kee and told them a story about a wellbeing coach who gives his audience of 300 a balloon to write their names on. He then puts the balloons into a room



and shuts the door. The audience is then asked to enter the room to find their balloon and is given a time limit of 5 minutes. Chaos ensues as everybody searches for their own balloon. Eventually the audience is called out with very few having found their balloon. The coach then asks the audience to go back into the room and this time

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they are asked to give the first balloon they find to the correct person. Within 2 minutes everybody had their balloon.

The balloons are like happiness. We will never find it if everyone is looking for their own. But if we care about other people's happiness... we'll find ours too.

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
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
Super Year 4 writing

Well done to Jace and John in Year 4 who were both sent to me to show me their incredible narrative writing based on a story called 'Leon and the place beyond'.




Reception writing stars Well done to Yaroslav and Finn for their fantastic writing. The class have been listening to and retelling the story of Goldilocks and the 3 bears.


