We spoke about how Jesus sets an example for us all to follow through his actions and words.

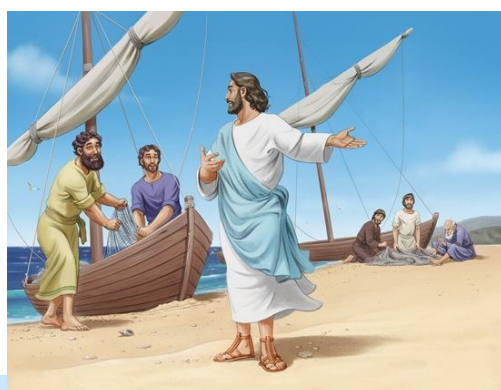

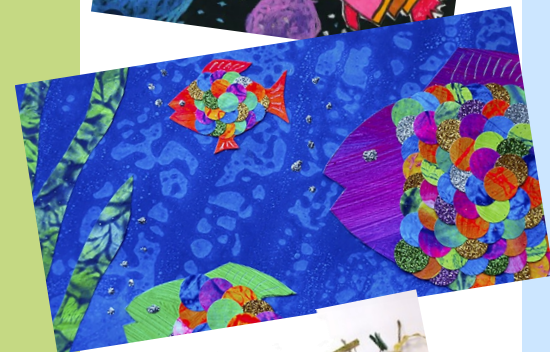

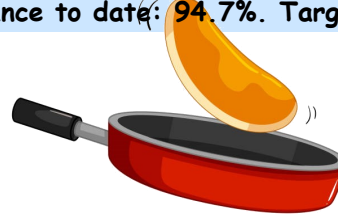
