Dear Parents and Carers,

Last Sunday's Gospel reading marked the first Sunday of Lent and told the story of Jesus' temptation when he was in the desert for 40 days and nights.

Lent is a time of repentance (turning back to God) - symbolised by the colour purple. During Lent we **PREPARE** by **FASTING** (going without), **PRAYING** (talking to God) and **ALMSGIVING** (giving to others less fortunate than ourselves).

In the story of the Prodigal Son the son returns home after squandering his fortune only to find his father waiting. It's as if he has been there the whole time. This is what God is like. He wants us to turn back to him and he will be waiting for us. I showed the children this painting by Kristi Valiant. It is called 'prodigal son'. See if they can explain its meaning.


Well done to Year 6 who won the attendance trophy before half term with 97.7% attendance!

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
### Half term creative homework


Please remember to hand in your children's creative homework from half term. I have asked them to design a stained glass window with the title 'Living life in all its fullness'.






### Catholic Children's Society 'My Voice Matters' Lenten appeal


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New Age Kurling

Once again you have all been wonderfully kind and your generosity will enrich the provision for our youngest children. Thank you again.




#### 'Walk with me'—prayer of the month recital.
