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Mini Vinnies



This week our Mini Vinnies were visited by Mrs Murray and her son Finn. Finn has Type 1 diabetes and Mrs Murray explained how this impacts his life and that of his family.

It was a real eye opener for everyone present and next week the Mini Vinnies will be thinking about what we could do as a school to support research in this area.

Watch this space for our next ACTION! Below is Finn's story......

At the age of 2 Finn was diagnosed with type 1 Diabetes. His parents realised that he was showing classic symptoms of the 3 T's increasingly tired, thirsty and needed the toilet more. He was admitted to Hillingdon Hospital with dangerously high blood sugars and was diagnosed with diabetes. He received fantastic care from Hillingdon Hospital's Children and Young People with Diabetes Team (CYPD) and was fitted with an insulin pump and blood glucose sensor which acts as an artificial pancreas. This has enabled him to have as normal a childhood as possible but requires continuous monitoring to prevent abnormal blood sugars which can make him very unwell and may lead to an emergency if not treated. "Don't worry it's not scary to have diabetes, its okay. "Finn Murray. Although in the last couple of years there has been vast improvements in the treatment of type 1 Diabetes there is currently no cure. JDRF (Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation) are a charity working tirelessly to try and find a cure and hope that one may be found in Finn's lifetime.
