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

school football team.



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
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#### Chess club

Well done to Zion and Martyna who were voted players of the week in chess club this week. We still have spaces in both clubs if children would like to join.







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
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### **Globe trotter!**


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Get involved! Next Friends meeting Will be on Thursday 25th April at 7pm
