A busy week in reception has seen lots of learning and some beautiful handwriting. There was even some clay modelling from some of our youngest pupils. What a great week!

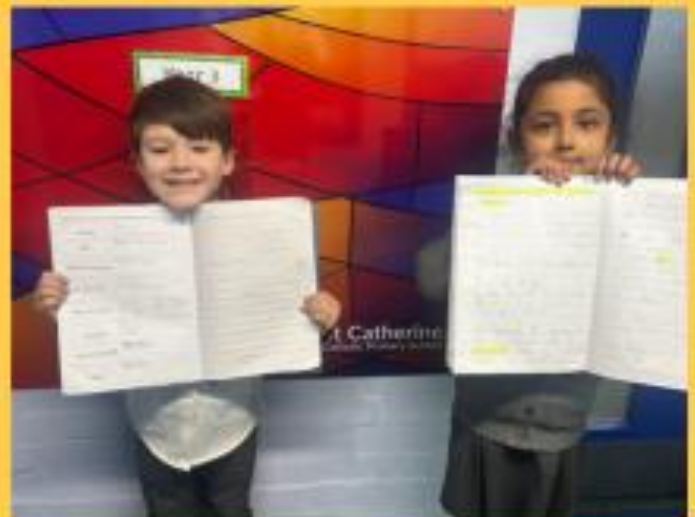
Year 1

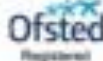
