SUMMER TERM-Reception

- Reception children will begin talking about 'moving-on' to Year 1.
- They will complete PSED activities based on how they feel, what they are looking forward to and/or may be worried about.
- The Year 1 teacher will spend time in Reception class getting to know the children.
- Reception class will begin lining-up on the KS2 playground in preparation for September
- The children will visit their new class and teacher.

AUTUMN TERM—Year 1



The Focus in this term will remain on the key principles of the EYFS: Literacy and Numeracy skills alongside Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- The children will access the National Curriculum alongside the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum.
- Any children below Nationally expected levels at the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage will continue to work on their EYFS Profiles throughout their first term in Year 1.
- The children will continue with the current Reception word box system throughout the first term but transfer onto the Year 1 Reading scheme.
- Handwriting practice will take place on a daily basis.
- An introduction to guided reading will take place for some children.
- The children will benefit from a play-based environment.
- Extra access to outside time.
- Familiar resources and routines

BEHAVIOUR STEPS

- Years 1-6 follow the school behaviour policy based on the principles of the behaviour steps. (Please refer to the School Behaviour steps document on the website)
- It is possible that your children may incur a lunchtime detention as part of this behaviour management strategy. You will be informed if this happens
- If your child receives three detentions in one week, they will automatically trigger a Step 3 letter home to parents.
- A copy of any Step 3 letters will be kept in your child's records, whilst at our school.

YEAR 1 REWARDS

- Children are rewarded with Golden Points and strive to achieve their Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum Certificates.
